



Regional Route Optimisation Programme

- Optimise the Arterial Road network on a four year cycle
 - Nov 2010-June 2011 optimisation of key under performing links, intersections and setup four year programme
 - Year 1 (11-12) Setup resources, funding and programme complete
 10% of network
 - Year 2 (12-13) Database development, standardise procedures +30% of network 40 % complete
 - Year 3 (13-14) Continued training and learning +30% of network 70% complete
 - Year 4 (14-15) Maintain and develop systems +30% of network 100% network optimisation, route reviews from year one or as required





Route Optimisation Programme 2011–2012

- Three major routes with full traffic signal route optimisation completed as at April 2012
 - Symonds Street Central Transport Corridor
 - St Lukes Road New North Road to Dominion Road
 - Dominion Road View Road to King Edward Road and Dexter through to Marsden Road





Additional optimisation projects

- In addition to the above route optimisation, reviews and improvements have been done between Nov 2010 and April 2012 at some intersections on the following routes to improve traffic flows.
 - Ponsonby Road
 - Karangahape Road
 - Mt Eden Road
 - Gillies Avenue
 - Remuera Road
 - East Coast Road (Greville to Sunrise)
 - Roscommon Road / Wiri Station Road
 - Onewa Road / Lake Road
 - Albany Highway / Upper Harbour Highway
 - Lincoln Road
 - Great North Road (Kelston-Glendene)
 - Great South Road (Takanini and Manurewa)
 - Quay Street, Fanshawe Street and Customs Street (RWC)





Route Optimisation Programme 2011 – 2012

- Major routes with full route optimisation in progress
 - Broadway
 - Great South Road
 - Broadway to Central Park; EP Highway to Princess Street, Mangere to Nicholson
 - Greenlane East
 - Greenlane West
 - Khyber Pass





Results so far (as at end March 2012)

For completed full route optimisation projects

Travel time savings	420,086	hours
CO ₂ emission reduction	1,388	tonnes
Fuel savings	559,527	litres
First year benefits	7.59	\$ million
Cost	0,19	\$ million
First Year Benefit/Cost ratio	39.9
